## **Full-Time Clinical Assistant Prep Course Summary**

<b>Course Title:</b>	Clinical Assistant Prep (CAP)
<b>Course Dates:</b>	December 17, 2018 – December 21, 2018
<b>Internship:</b>	January 14, 2019 – April 19, 2019 (8 hours/week minimum)
<b>Course Length:</b>	1-week on-campus; optional 13-week clinical internship
<b>Total hours:</b>	40 hours; minimum 100-hour clinical internship
<b>Days/Times:</b>	Monday – Friday 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM
<b>Pre-requisite:</b>	The full-time section is strictly for <b>FSU Medical Response Unit</b> students and/or students who are classed as a <b>Junior/Senior/PostBac at the university level</b> . You may be asked to provide documents showing that you meet this criterion.
<b>Program Description:</b>	The Clinical Assistant Prep (CAP) course will teach foundational knowledge and basic science in medical terminology, basic pharmacology and nutrition, and anatomy and physiology, clinical patient care in electrocardiography, phlebotomy, parenteral administration, point of care testing, assessment & management skills of the patient, and administrative tasks as it applies to a clinical medical assistant. The achievement of these skills will allow students to obtain an optional, successful volunteer-based internship in the clinical setting with <b>direct patient care experience</b> . All students will be eligible to sit for the national certification exam in clinical medical assisting upon successful completion of the program.
<b>Course Requirements:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- <b>Students must maintain an 85% or higher academic average and 90% or higher in attendance to participate in the clinical internship.</b></li><li>- Students have the opportunity to participate in the optional, one semester clinical internship, which will immediately follow course completion. The student must intern at a minimum of 8 hours per week which can be fulfilled by interning for one (1) full day 8a-5p OR two (2) half days – 8a-12p OR 1p-5p.</li><li>- Students will be practicing venipuncture skills on each other.</li><li>- Students must have access to a computer &amp; Internet, as this is a web-assisted course.</li></ul>
